PUBLIC SPAY/NEUTER FEES

Minimum age 4 months

Prices for dogs include post-surgical pain medication.

There is a 90#weight limit for female dogs.

Dog spay\$110.00 up to 60#*	Cat spay\$65.00
Dog alter\$90.00 up to 60#*	Cat alter\$45.00

***Dogs, add \$10.00 for each additional 10# over 60#.**

Pets older than 5 years may be required to have pre-surgical bloodwork.

The cost is of a blood chemistry panel is \$95.00.

Cats:

Proof of rabies vaccine is required at the time of surgery. If you cannot provide proof of vaccination you will need to get a rabies vaccine for your pet on the day of surgery.

This program is *only* for families with household incomes below \$45,000.00 per year.

Thank you for requesting information about our spay/neuter program. Our program is designed to help reduce some of the costs involved in spaying or neutering your pet.

If you are unable to afford our fees and your income is below \$45,000.00 per year, you may apply for a reduced cost voucher. This program is done through the mail and you must provide proof of income. **You must receive your low cost voucher before you schedule your surgery appointment.**

If your yearly household income is (proof required) between **\$35,000-\$45,000**, your cost for a normal operation is:

Female dog spay.....\$80.00	Female cat spay.....\$55.00
Male dog neuter.....\$65.00	Male cat neuter.....\$35.00

If your yearly household income is (proof required) between **\$25,000-\$35,000**, your cost for a normal operation is:

Female dog spay.....\$50.00	Female cat spay.....\$35.00
Male dog neuter.....\$45.00	Male cat neuter.....\$25.00

If your yearly household income (proof required) is between **\$0-\$25,000**, your cost for a normal operation is:

Female dog spay.....\$40.00	Female cat spay.....\$30.00
Male dog neuter.....\$35.00	Male cat Neuter.....\$20.00

Please note: Extra charges may apply if your pet is not up to date with its shots, is in heat or pregnant, has retained testicles or is over the veterinarians weight limit or has other conditions that may affect surgery.

You must pay the veterinarian directly for these extra charges.
